



Beginning in 2010, the United States Mint will issue coins featuring national parks and historic sites with new quarters minted and issued in accordance with the "America's Beautiful National Parks Quarter Dollar Coin Act of 2008" (Act).



With the United States National Site Commemorative Quarter Folder, collection and display of these coins honors American ideals such as liberty and justice, rich history and heritage. This program demonstrates our nation's commitment and dedication to the legacy of conservation as well as celebrates our Nation's natural beauty for many years to come.



Thanks to this innovative multi-year program, you will see a new design emblematic of a national site depicted on the reverse of the quarter approximately every 10 weeks for 11 years. The folder features quality vinyl construction with a distinctive embossed title. Clear pockets for display of all 56 quarters are positioned in the order of coin release.



The sites selected for this series of quarters will come from each of 56 host jurisdictions comprising the 50 States, the District of Columbia and each U.S. territory (the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, the U.S. Virgin Islands, and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands). A portrait of George Washington will remain on the obverse of all the quarters.
